### School Meals

The Government Free School Meal Grant is unconnected to YR and KS1 Universal Free School Meals. The school receives significant funding for each child in receipt of FSM. This has a direct impact both on the child themselves and on the overall school budget which is directly related to how many pupils the school has on FSM. If you think you may be eligible, please apply via [www.bromley.gov.uk](http://www.bromley.gov.uk) or call into the Office for further details. All those whose applications are successful will receive are entitled to a free item of uniform.

Please ensure your child wears the correct uniform. Charcoal Grey trousers, skirts, and pinafores, white shirts.


